CICLOPIROX OLAMINE 1.5% SHAMPOO

Drug family: Local antifungal

This drug is a generic of SEBIPROX

IN WHICH CASE IS THE DRUG CICLOPIROX OLAMINE PRESCRIBED?

This shampoo contains a local action antifungal. It is used in the treatment of seborrheic dermatitis of the scalp.

PRESENTATIONS OF THE DRUG CICLOPIROX OLAMINE

CICLOPIROX OLAMINE 1.5%: shampoo; 100ml bottle

COMPOSITION OF THE DRUG CICLOPIROX OLAMINE

per 100g, Ciclopirox olamine 1.5g

Active substance: Ciclopirox olamine

Excipients: Citric acid monohydrate, Oleic alcohol, Cocoamidopropyl betaine, Coco fatty acid diethanolamide, Purified water, Hexylene glycol, Sodium laureth sulfate, Parfum, Disodium phosphate dodecahydrate, Polyguaternium 10, Polysorbate 80, Sodium hydroxide

ATTENTION

Rinse thoroughly with water in case of accidental eye contact to avoid eye irritation.

FERTILITY, PREGNANCY AND LACTATION

The effect of this medicine during pregnancy or lactation is not well known. The assessment of the possible risk linked to its use is individual: ask your pharmacist or your doctor for advice.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE AND DOSAGE OF THE DRUG CICLOPIROX OLAMINE

Wet the hair and apply a sufficient quantity of shampoo in order to obtain an abundant foam. Vigorously rub the scalp and, if necessary, the areas around it, then rinse. Repeat the operation. Leave on for 3 to 5 minutes in total for the 2 applications.



USUAL DOSE:

Adult and teenager over 12 years old : 1 shampoo, 2 to 3 times a week. The duration of treatment is usually 4 weeks.

ADVICE

A mild shampoo can be used between applications of this treatment shampoo.

The factors triggering or aggravating flare-ups of seborrheic dermatitis (stress, emotional shock , taking medication, etc.) must be identified and avoided if possible.

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS OF THE DRUG CICLOPIROX OLAMINE

Very common (more than 10% of cases): skin irritation, itching.

Frequent (1 to 10% of cases): redness or rash, burning sensation of the skin.

Rare: eczema , scales , hair loss, change in hair texture or color, mainly in people who color or have gray or white hair.

Skin irritation, itching and skin redness are also symptoms of the disease. They are considered undesirable effects if an aggravation of these symptoms is observed.
